

Paraments

The season of the Christ Child is represented by a brilliant golden star, the star that appeared in the East. Its radiant beams streaming downward toward earth are embroidered upon a Pulpit Scarf of white needlepoint, symbolizing purity. Upon each white Bible Marker is the Chi Rho, designed with a horizontal bar over the top of the two cross bars of Chi, suggesting a manger, intersected by the vertical symbol, Rho.
