Why not prepare for worship by simply praying Psalm 119:18? "Open my eyes that I may behold wondrous things out of your law." Thomas Cranmer's beloved prayer for illumination fleshes out this verse from the Psalms.

Blessed Lord, You have caused all holy Scriptures to be written for our learning; grant that we may hear them, read, mark, learn, and inwardly digest them, that by patience and comfort of Your holy Word, we may embrace, and ever hold fast the blessed hope of everlasting life, that You have given us in our Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.
