We have been rescued and redeemed from all the ways that we have trampled on other people's dignity and good reputation by the One who called Himself "The Truth" and "The Faithful Witness."

"The denial that truth exists is a good beginning for habitual lying. And if we start confessing our habitual lies, shall we ever be done? There are lies of gossip which make haters out of us, there are lies of advertising that make money out of us, there are lies of politicians which make power out of us. The point here is that every lie demeans and tramples on another person's dignity." — Joy Davidman
