## Preparation for Worship

When it looks like our enemies are winning, we remember that Jesus promises that nothing will destroy His Church. As the King, He restrains all of His enemies and will eventually conquer them and establish His kingdom. For this, we delight to worship our eternal King.

Question 26 of the Westminster Shorter Catechism reminds us of what King Jesus does: He subdues us to Himself, rules and defends us, and restrains and conquers all of His and our enemies.

As a result of worship today, may the Spirit empower you to:

- Fully surrender the throne of your heart to your King.
- Name your rival kings and pseudo saviors, and confess your idols.
- Pray and expect big things from your good and mighty King.

John Newton reminds us of how we should pray to our God: "Thou art coming to a King, large petitions with thee bring; for His grace and power are such, none can ever ask too much."

Let us gaze and glory and give ourselves again to our great King!
