I confess Thy judgment just; speechless, I Thy mercy trust.**

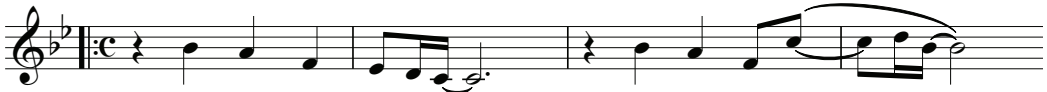
**I am evil, born in sin; Thou desirest truth within.
